- We are learning about types of weather at this time of year!
- We will be talking about people who work through the night e.g. nurses, firefighters and doctors.
- We will also be learning about nocturnal animals , safety at home, Dinosaurs and space.

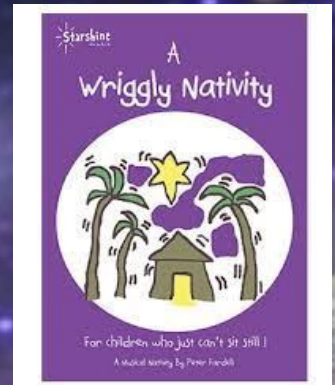
